AND, OF COURSE, THERE WAS THE MOST MEMORABLE EXPERIENCE OF ALL--TRYING TO GET TICKETS TO THE BASEBALL ALL-STAR GAME. ***I'LL KEEP MY REMARKS** SHORT, SO I CAN LEAVE PLENTY OF TIME FOR QUESTIONS, AND **GIVEN THE FACT THAT THERE** ARE REPUBLICANS AND **DEMOCRATS HERE, I'LL TRY AND**

BE MY NORMAL BI-PARTISAN SELF.

***I DO WANT TO MAKE A FEW** POINTS, AND THE FIRST IS THAT I HOPE IN 10 OR 15 YEARS, ONE OF YOU WILL BE UP HERE, SPEAKING TO A SIMILAR GROUP. ***YOU'RE LEARNING AT AN** EARLY AGE THAT IF YOU WANT TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE...IF YOU WANT TO CHANGE AMERICA,

THEN YOU'VE GOT TO GET INVOLVED. YOU CAN'T SIT ON THE SIDELINES. POLITICS IS NOT A SPECTATOR SPORT. ***THAT'S A LESSON I LEARNED** WHEN I WAS LAW SCHOOL BACK IN KANSAS. I REMEMBER OUR LAW LIBRARIAN--WHO **HAPPENED TO BE A DEMOCRAT--**BROUGHT FOUR OF US STUDENTS TOGETHER, TWO

REPUBLICANS AND TWO DEMOCRATS, AND TOLD US THAT WE OUGHT TO RUN FOR OFFICE.

*UP UNTIL THAT TIME, I HADN'T THOUGHT ABOUT A CAREER IN PUBLIC SERVICE. I HADN'T THE FOGGIEST NOTION WHAT POLITICS WAS ALL ABOUT. BUT I DID KNOW THAT I WANTED TO MAKE A

DIFFERENCE. AND THE MORE I THOUGHT ABOUT IT, THE MORE **IT SEEMED THAT POLITICS OFFERED AN OPPORTUNITY TO** MAKE THAT DIFFERENCE. ***SO FOUR OF US RAN FOR** THE LEGISLATURE--AND TWO OF **US, ONE REPUBLICAN AND ONE DEMOCRAT--WON. AND THAT'S** HOW I GOT STARTED.

ONE PROBLEM FOR MANY YEARS TO COME.

***THIS YEAR, 14% OF YOUR** TAX DOLLARS WILL NOT GO FOR **GOODS OR SERVICES, BUT** MERELY FOR INTEREST ON THE **\$4 TRILLION NATIONAL DEBT.** AND SINCE HUNDRED BILLION DOLLAR DEFICITS ARE FORECAST FOR THE IMMEDIATE FUTURE, TAXES TO FINANCE THE

DEBT ARE ALMOST CERTAIN TO BE MUCH HIGHER ON YOUR GENERATION THAN THEY WERE ON MINE.

*IF YOU'RE LIKE ME, IT'S HARD TO IMAGINE WHAT TRILLIONS OF DOLLARS REALLY MEANS, BUT LET ME JUST DETAIL WHAT YOU COULD DO WITH FOUR TRILLION: YOU COULD BUY AN AVERAGE SIZE **IN-GROUND CONCRETE** SWIMMING POOL FOR EVERY **HOMEOWNER IN AMERICA; PAY** A 40-HOUR-A-WEEK MINIMUM WAGE PAYCHECK TO EVERY PERSON IN THE WORLD; PAY A YEAR OF TUITION TO HARVARD FOR EVERY HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT IN AMERICA, AND BUY **EVERY 1993 COLLEGE GRADUATE IN AMERICA A NEW**

B.M.W. AND A TWO WEEK CLUB-MED VACATION--AND YOU'D **STILL HAVE MORE THAN \$3** TRILLION LEFT OVER. ***THE MESSAGE IS SIMPLE. AMERICA NEEDS** COMPREHENSIVE, LONG-TERM, **ENFORCEABLE DEFICIT REDUCTION TO SUSTAIN** ECONOMIC GROWTH, AND TO **BAISE YOUR STANDARD OF**

LIVING AND THAT OF YOUR
