JENNIFER DUNN: Praise her for leadership in reforming way Congress does business. She is only freshman member on special joint committee created to reform Congress.

\*Los Angeles Times recently selected her as one of the five most impressive new members of Congress.

\*Urge Republicans to give Dunn more "team mates in House. She's not only the "President" of the Washington Republican House Delegation, she's also the Vice President, the Secretary, and the Treasurer (only Republican in 9 member House delegation)

\*As Washington GOP Chairman, Dunn began "three strikes and you're out effort," after party employee was murdered by repeat violent offender.

SLADE GORTON: Praise Gorton for insisting that "three strikes and you're out" be included in crime bill.

\*Gorton also fighting against Clinton's "war against the west." Clinton administration admitted last week that their spotted own plan will cost twice as many jobs as originally estimated.

\*Gorton is aggressively running grass roots campaign...They already have 15,000 individual contributors.
