



THANK YOU. I HAVE TO SAY THAT "NINE" IS BECOMING MY FAVORITE NUMBER. FIRST, REPUBLICANS GAINED NINE SEATS IN THE UNITES STATES SENATE, AND NOW NINE OF US ARE **RECEIVING HONORARY DEGREES FROM YESHIVA.** ALSO, NINE TIMES TWO EQUALS **EIGHTEEN, AND I UNDERSTAND**

THAT NORMAN LAMM--THE DISTINGUISHED LEADER OF YESHIVA UNIVERSITY--IS CELEBRATING THE 18TH OR "HI" ANNIVERSARY OF HIS PRESIDENCY AT THIS TIME.

I KNOW THAT IN THE JEWISH TRADITION, HAI SYMBOLIZES LIFE AND GOOD FORTUNE, SO MAY I ADD MY PERSONAL CONGRATULATIONS TO YOU, DR.

LAMM, AND WISH BOTH OF YOU AND THE UNIVERSITY LONG LIFE AND CONTINUED SUCCESS. AND I KNOW I SPEAK FOR ALL TODAY'S RECIPIENTS IN SAYING

WHAT A PRIVILEGE IT IS TO BE

HONORED BY THE

ADMINISTRATION, FACULTY,

STUDENTS AND FRIENDS OF YESHIVA UNIVERSITY.

THIS IS A TIME IN OUR NATION'S **HISTORY WHEN MANY AMERICANS ARE SEARCHING FOR MEANING IN** THEIR LIVES AND IN THE VALUES OF **OUR SOCIETY. AND THIS IS AN** INSTITUTION THAT ADDRESSES THESE NEEDS IN A VERY SPECIAL WAY.

ALL AMERICANS WOULD BE WISE TO LEARN FROM THE YESHIVA EXPERIENCE. THE BLENDING OF

THE STUDY OF TRADITIONAL VALUES WITH A MODERN, **TWENTIETH-CENTURY CURRICULUM** PRODUCES GRADUATES WHO ARE WELL-PREPARED TO MEET PERSONAL AS WELL AS PROFESSIONAL CHALLENGES. **MY REMARKS WILL BE BRIEF.** SPEAKERS AT CEREMONIES LIKE THIS ONE ARE LIKE BODIES AT A FUNERAL. THEY CAN'T HOLD THE

EVENT WITHOUT YOU, BUT NOBODY EXPECTS YOU TO SAY VERY MUCH. HOWEVER, I THOUGHT I MIGHT **USE THIS OCCASION TO COMMENT ON THE REPUBLICAN PERSPECTIVE ON THE FUTURE OF FOREIGN** ASSISTANCE AND THE CONTINUED **AMERICAN ROLE IN THE MIDDLE** EAST PEACE PROCESS. **REPUBLICANS BELIEVE FOREIGN** ASSISTANCE SHOULD FIRST AND

FOREMOST PROMOTE THE SECURITY INTERESTS OF THE UNITED STATES. AND MOST OF US **BELIEVE ASSISTANCE TO THE CAMP** DAVID COUNTRIES OF ISRAEL AND EGYPT CLEARLY DOES JUST THAT. Z SIMPLY PUT, WE HAVE NO CLOSER ALLY THAN ISRAEL. AND THERE CAN BE NO DOUBT THAT **U.S. ASSISTANCE TO ISRAEL HAS** ADVANCED OUR SHARED

INTERESTS AND VALUES IN A REGION UNFORTUNATELY NOT NOTED FOR FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY.

THE HISTORIC PROGRESS THAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED IN THE MIDDLE EAST HAS BEEN ACHIEVED ONLY BECAUSE THE UNITED STATES AND ISRAEL HAVE STOOD TOGETHER, AND ONLY BECAUSE ISRAEL HAS REMAINED STRONG AND SECURE.

THE FIRST OF THE ARAB LEADERS TO UNDERSTAND THAT **REAL PEACE WITH ISRAEL WAS IN** EVERYONE'S INTEREST WAS ANWAR SADAT. IT TOOK MORE THAN A DECADE FOR OTHERS TO REACH THE SAME **UNDERSTANDING, BUT RECENT EVENTS HAVE BEEN ENCOURAGING,** AS THE TUNISIANS, MOROCCANS, THE OMANIS, AND MOST

IMPORTANTLY, THE JORDANIANS HAVE TAKEN STEPS TO NORMALIZE **RELATIONS WITH ISRAEL.** SEEING ISRAEL'S LEADERS SITTING TOGETHER WITH KING **HUSSEIN AND OTHER JORDANIAN** LEADERS LAST MONTH CLEARLY **DEMONSTRATES HOW FAR THE MIDDLE EAST HAS MOVED TOWARD** REAL PEACE.

WHILE MUCH PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE AND PRESSURE FOR EVEN MORE PROGRESS IS GREAT, **ISRAEL STILL FACES MANY VERY** SERIOUS THREATS. MANY PALESTINIANS STILL DO NOT ACCEPT THE RIGHT OF ISRAELIS TO LIVE IN PEACE AND SECURITY. THE HORRIBLE BOMBING IN TEL AVIV LAST MONTH AND THE BRUTAL AX MURDER OF A FEMALE ISRAELI

SOLDIER LAST WEEK SHOW THE BENEFITS OF PEACE WITH THE P.L.O. REMAIN ELUSIVE.

MOST DISTURBING OF ALL IS THE **APPARENT INABILITY OF ARAFAT** AND HIS ASSISTANTS TO CONTROL THE PALESTINIAN EXTREMISTS. THIS FAILURE HAS PLACED THE **ISRAELI PEOPLE IN A VERY** DIFFICULT POSITION: THEY ARE **BEING ASKED TO RELINQUISH**

AUTHORITY OVER AREAS CRUCIAL TO ISRAEL'S SECURITY TO UNTESTED PALESTINIAN LEADERSHIP. AND ARAFAT HIMSELF MAY BE THE NEXT TARGET OF HAMAS.

ONE WAY TO HELP IS TO DEMONSTRATE THE BENEFITS OF PEACE TO PALESTINIANS IN GAZA THROUGH ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY. BY THIS I MEAN DEVELOPMENT OF SMALL BUSINESSES, JOBS, AND THE REBUILDING OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE, SO THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE CAN DEVOTE THEIR ENERGY TO BETTERING THEIR OWN LIVES.

THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY HAS PLEDGED HUNDREDS OF MILLIONS OF DOLLARS TO THIS EFFORT. BUT

THE FLOW OF MONEY HAS BEEN SLOWED BY INTERNATIONAL **CONCERNS OVER ACCOUNTABILITY PROCEDURES. I BELIEVE THAT IF** THE PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY CAN NOT GIVE US ADEQUATE **ASSURANCES THAT THE AID WILL BE USED PROPERLY, WE SHOULD** LOOK FOR WAYS TO DELIVER AID **DIRECTLY TO THE PALESTINIAN** PEOPLE.

GENUINE PEACE WITH SYRIA IS ANOTHER DIFFICULT ISSUE. WHILE THE PARTIES ARE NOW TALKING, AGREEMENT ON ISSUES LIKE NORMALIZED RELATIONS, TOURISM, TRADE AND ALL OF THE NORMAL EXCHANGES ENJOYED BY **COUNTRIES TRULY AT PEACE WITH ONE ANOTHER ARE VERY FAR** AWAY.

MORE DISTURBING STILL IS THE **CONTINUED SYRIAN OCCUPATION** OF LEBANON. WITHIN THE **LEBANESE TERRITORIES** CONTROLLED BY SYRIA, **HEZBOLLAH OPERATES FREELY**, PLOTTING AND PLANNING ITS TERRORIST ACTIVITIES. DRUG TRAFFICKERS OPERATE WITH IMPUNITY. UNTIL SYRIA ENDS HEZBOLLAH'S FREEDOM AND DRUG **TRAFFICKING IN THE SYRIAN-**CONTROLLED AREAS OF LEBANON. **ONE HAS TO QUESTION THE SYRIAN GOVERNMENT'S COMMITMENT TO REAL AND LASTING PEACE.** PEACE WITH SYRIA WILL ONLY COME AFTER ASSAD **DEMONSTRATES THROUGH DEEDS**--AND NOT WORDS--THAT HE HAS MADE A REAL DECISION TO PURSUE PEACE AS A STRATEGIC COURSE,

RATHER THAN A TACTICAL OPPORTUNITY. AND THE IDEA OF DEPLOYING **AMERICAN FORCES ON THE GOLAN HEIGHTS -- AS PART OF A FUTURE PEACE ACCORD -- SHOULD HAVE** CAREFUL SCRUTINY. THERE ARE MANY QUESTIONS ABOUT ANY SUCH DEPLOYMENT -- BUT MOST **CANNOT BE ANSWERED IN ADVANCE OF A CONCRETE**

PROPOSAL. THE VIEW OF THE CONGRESS, FOR EXAMPLE, WOULD BE VERY DIFFERENT TOWARD A DIVISION-SIZE AMERICAN-ONLY FORCE OF PEACEKEEPERS THAN IT WOULD BE TO A SMALL **CONTRIBUTION TO A MULTINATIONAL FORCE OF** MONITORS.

THE PROBLEMS FACED BY ISRAEL WITH SYRIA AND THE

PALESTINIANS ARE COMPOUNDED BY THE THREATS FROM IRAO AND **IRAN. BOTH OF THESE ROGUE** STATES HAVE DIRECTLY THREATENED THE SECURITY OF **ISRAEL. EACH HAS SUPPORTED TERRORIST ATTACKS UPON ISRAEL** AND HAS REJECTED THE PROSPECT OF PEACE. OF GREATEST CONCERN, HOWEVER, ARE THE ATTEMPTS BY THESE STATES TO

ATTAIN WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION. AS THE GULF WAR **ILLUSTRATED, ISRAEL IS CLEARLY** WITHIN THE RANGE OF HOSTILE MISSILES. ISRAEL CAN NEVER BE SECURE SO LONG AS THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY **ALLOWS IRAO AND IRAN TO CONTINUE TO ACQUIRE MORE AND** MORE SOPHISTICATED WEAPONRY.

ALL THE QUESTIONS AND CHALLENGES I HAVE LISTED LEAD **TO ONLY ONE CONCLUSION--NOW** IS NOT THE TIME TO REDUCE U.S. ASSISTANCE TO ISRAEL. AS ISRAEL **CONTINUES TO NEGOTIATE WITH** SYRIA AND WITH THE PALESTINIANS, NO ONE SHOULD DOUBT FOR A MOMENT THE FULL **COMMITMENT OF THE UNITED**

STATES TO THE SECURITY OF ISRAEL.

AND SINCE I AM IN THE CITY WHICH IS HOME TO THE UNITED NATIONS, LET ME CONCLUDE BY **DISCUSSING MY TRIP TO EUROPE** LAST WEEK, AND MY MUCH PUBLICIZED DISAGREEMENT WITH THE POLICY OF THE UNITED NATIONS, NATO, AND THE CLINTON ADMINISTRATION WITH REGARDS

AS A WORLD WAR II VETERAN, I THOUGHT I HAD SEEN THE LAST OF **CONCENTRATION CAMPS IN** EUROPE. I COULD NEVER IMAGINE THAT THE WORLD WOULD ONCE AGAIN TOLERATE GENOCIDE ON THE EUROPEAN CONTINENT. SADLY, I WAS WRONG.

THE FAILURE OF THE WEST TO ACT ON ITS PROMISES AND **COMMITMENTS TO BOSNIA IS** SHAMEFUL. STRONG RESOLUTIONS **ARE PASSED IN THE UNITED** NATIONS AND IN NATO, BUT THE **U.N. AND NATO SIT BY AS BIHAC IS** DESTROYED. THE FAILURE IN **BOSNIA HAS DESTROYED THE** CREDIBILITY OF THE U.N. AND

THREATENED THE CREDIBILITY OF NATO.

THE FAMOUS WORDS OF EDMUND BURKE, REPEATED TO ME WHEN I MET WITH FORMER PRIME **MINISTER THATCHER LAST WEEK,** SUM UP THE BOSNIAN TRAGEDY: **"THE ONLY THING NECESSARY FOR EVIL TO TRIUMPH IS FOR GOOD** MEN TO DO NOTHING."

IN BOSNIA TODAY, AS IN **ARMENIA, IN THE HOLOCAUST, AND** IN THE KILLING FIELDS OF CAMBODIA, EVIL TRIUMPHED BECAUSE GOOD MEN DID NOTHING. IN CLOSING, LET ME SHARE WITH YOU SOME WORDS OF THE **GREATEST FOREIGN POLICY** PRESIDENT OF OUR TIME--RICHARD NIXON. LAST JANUARY, PRESIDENT NIXON SAID, AND I QUOTE--

"SOME ARE TIRED OF LEADERSHIP," "THEY SAY (AMERICA) CARRIED THAT BURDEN LONG ENOUGH. BUT IF WE DO NOT **PROVIDE LEADERSHIP, WHO WILL?** THE GERMANS? THE JAPANESE? THE RUSSIANS? THE CHINESE? NO. **ONLY THE UNITED STATES HAS THE** POTENTIAL...TO LEAD IN THE ERA **BEYOND PEACE. IT IS A GREAT** CHALLENGE FOR A GREAT PEOPLE."

PRESIDENT NIXON WAS RIGHT. THE UNITED STATES MAY BE AT PEACE, BUT EVENTS IN BOSNIA, THE MIDEAST, NORTH KOREA AND **ELSEWHERE REMIND US THAT** DICTATORS STILL EXIST, THAT **AGGRESSORS WHO ARE NOT** STOPPED WILL ONLY GROW MORE **BRAZEN AND MORE BLOOD-**THIRSTY, AND THAT AMERICAN LEADERSHIP IS STILL REQUIRED.

WHEN AMERICA'S INTERESTS ARE AT STAKE, WHEN FREEDOM IS THREATENED, THEN, LIKE IT OR NOT, WE ARE THE "COP ON THE BEAT." WE ARE THE WORLD'S **ONLY ECONOMIC, MILITARY, AND** POLITICAL SUPERPOWER. AND WE MUST LEAD. THAT IS THE UNDERLYING PRINCIPLE THAT WILL **GUIDE THE ACTIONS OF THE**

REPUBLICAN MAJORITY IN THE 104TH CONGRESS. AGAIN, MY THANKS FOR HONORING ME TODAY, AND ALLOWING ME TO PLAY A SMALL

ROLE IN THE LIFE OF THIS HISTORIC UNIVERSITY.
