1946 AND 1952--THEY LOST

CONTROL IN THE FOLLOWING ELECTION.

WELL, NEWT, I JUST ONE TO
TELL YOU THAT I SERVED WITH JOE
MARTIN. JOE MARTIN WAS A
FRIEND OF MINE. AND NEWT,
YOU'RE NO JOE MARTIN.

THIS CAMPAIGN CYCLE--MISSING
ONLY HAWAII, ALASKA, (DON
YOUNG DIDN'T NEED MY HELP),

AND FOR SOME REASON, ARKANSAS. AND WHEREVER I WENT, I TOLD THE AMERICAN PEOPLE THAT AFTER 40 YEARS OF DEMOCRAT CONTROL, THEY SHOULD GIVE REPUBLICANS A CHANCE. AND IF THEY DIDN'T LIKE WHAT WE DID, THEN THEY COULD **THROW US OUT FOR ANOTHER 40** YEARS.

IN THE LAST FEW WEEKS, I
THINK THE AMERICAN PEOPLE HAVE

SEEN THAT WE ARE BACKING UP OUR RHETORIC WITH ACTION. AND I WANT TO CONGRATULATE DAVE DRIER, JIM NUSSLE, JENNIFER DUNN, AND ALL THOSE INVOLVED IN THE PROCESS OF SHRINKING THE HOUSE BUREAUCRACY. THAT'S A BIT TOUGHER TO DO IN THE SENATE, BUT WE'VE MADE IT VERY CLEAR THAT IN THE FIRST DAYS WE WILL ALSO REDUCE THE NUMBER

OF SENATE EMPLOYEES, AND WE
WILL JOIN YOU IN MAKING SURE
THAT CONGRESS LIVES UNDER THE
SAME LAWS WE IMPOSE ON
EVERYONE ELSE.

WE DO HAVE DIFFERENT RULES,
AND WE DO OPERATE AT
DIFFERENT SPEEDS. SOMETIMES
THE SENATE MAY GO SLOW ON
LEGISLATION YOU PASS RAPIDLY.
AND SOMETIMES YOU MAY GO

SLOW ON LEGISLATION WE PASS
RAPIDLY. BUT AS NEWT HAS SAID,
THERE'S NOTHING WRONG WITH
GOING SLOW, AS LONG AS WE
"GO," AND AS LONG AS WE'RE
MOVING FORWARD.

IN CLOSING, I WANT TO SHARE
WITH YOU A STORY TOLD ABOUT
THE NIGHT IN 1945, WHEN
GENERAL DWIGHT EISENHOWER
WAS WALKING ALONG THE RHINE,

THINKING OF THE CROSSING IN WHICH HE WOULD LEAD THE ALLIED ARMIES.

ON HIS WALK, HE MET A
SOLDIER, AND ASKED HIM WHY HE
WASN'T SLEEPING. THE YOUNG
G.I., WHO DIDN'T RECOGNIZE
EISENHOWER IN THE DARK, SAID, "I
GUESS I'M JUST A LITTLE
NERVOUS."

"SO AM I," SAID EISENHOWER.

"LET'S WALK TOGETHER, AND

PERHAPS WE'LL DRAW STRENGTH

FROM ONE ANOTHER."

I THINK ALL OF US ARE A BIT
AWED ABOUT THE RESPONSIBILITY
THAT AWAITS US IN JANUARY.
BUT I KNOW THAT BY WORKING
TOGETHER ON THE BUDGET, ON
CRIME, ON WELFARE REFORM, AND
ON EVERY OTHER ISSUE, WE WILL

DRAW STRENGTH FROM THE

AMERICAN PEOPLE, AND WE WILL

ENSURE THAT AMERICA'S BEST

DAYS ARE YET TO COME.
