Washington, D.C., December 20 -- Elizabeth Dole, President of the American Red Cross, entered Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston today, and this morning will undergo surgery to clear a blockage in the artery in the right side of her neck.

"The problem is isolated in the one spot on the one artery, and we expect no complications," Dr. Robert G. Ojemann, Mrs. Dole's surgeon, said today. "Mrs. Dole is in superb physical condition, she has no symptoms, we found no other blockage in her system, and no other risk factors, so we expect the procedure to be routine, and she should have an expeditious recovery." She is expected to be released from the hospital in five days.

The blockage in Mrs. Dole's right carotid artery was discovered during her recent annual physical.

I have checked into Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, and will undergo surgery at 8 o'clock this morning to clear a blockage in the artery in the right side of my neck, or my right carotid artery. Although my doctors do not know what caused the blockage -- I am in excellent health, have no symptoms and no other blockage in my system -- they describe my surgery as routine and expect no complications.

My condition was discovered during my recent annual physical, and came as a surprise to everyone. On the whole, I'd rather have found coal in my stocking, but my doctors have assured me I'll be out of the hospital during the holidays.

Best wishes to you and your families for a joyous holiday season. Thank you all for another wonderful year of dedicated service -- and special thanks to our Red Crossers who will be away from their families during the holidays, carrying out our mission.
