TONIGHT WILL BE BRIEF. I HAD A

GREAT SPEECH ALL READY TO GO,

BUT I DECIDED TO LET SONNY

BONO GIVE IT LAST WEEK.

YOU HAVE TO ADMIT THAT THIS
HAS BEEN AN INTERESTING YEAR.
THANKS TO THE VOTERS, SONNY
BONO WENT FROM SHOW BUSINESS
TO POLITICS, AND MARIO CUOMO

AND ANN RICHARDS WENT FROM POLITICS TO SHOW BUSINESS. I DON'T KNOW HOW MANY OF YOU SAW THEIR COMMERCIAL **DURING YESTERDAY'S SUPER** BUT POLITICIANS ENDORS PRODUCTS CATCHES ON, I EXPECT YOU'LL SEE EVER READY **BATTERIES ASKING STROM** THURMOND TO BE THEIR NATIONAL SPOKESMAN. AFTER ALL, STROM

JUST KEEPS GOING AND GOING AND GOING.

STROM TOLD ME THE OTHER DAY THAT HE HAS NOW PARTICIPATED IN TWO REVOLUTIONS. THE FIRST, OF COURSE, WAS THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION. AND THE SECOND IS THE REPUBLICAN REVOLUTION OF 1994.

BOTH REVOLUTIONS CAN BE

SUMMED UP IN THREE LITTLE
WORDS--THE WORDS "WE, THE
PEOPLE."

IN 1776, THE PEOPLE RALLIED
BEHIND THE CRY THAT "TAXATION
WITHOUT REPRESENTATION IS
TYRANNY," AND THEY CREATED A
NEW COUNTRY IN THE PROCESS.

AND IN 1994, THE PEOPLE

RECLAIMED THEIR COUNTRY WHEN

THEY REALIZED THAT TAXATION

WITH DEMOCRAT REPRESENTATION
WASN'T MUCH BETTER.

ALL OF US ARE HERE TONIGHT TO MAKE SURE THAT THE **REPUBLICAN REVOLUTION OF 1994** KEEPS ON GOING AND GOING. NO DOUBT ABOUT IT, NOVEMBER'S LANDSLIDE WILL SHAPE AMERICA'S POLITICAL LANDSCAPE FOR MANY YEARS TO COME.

AND THE LONGEST LASTING

EFFECTS OF THAT ELECTION--FOR

OUR PARTY AND OUR COUNTRY-
MAY WELL COME FROM THE

SUCCESS OF THE RGA AND OUR

REPUBLICAN GUBERNATORIAL

CANDIDATES.

HAVING REPUBLICANS IN
CHARGE OF 30 STATES DOES MANY

FIRST, IT ENSURES THAT THE

OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS OF

REPUBLICAN GOVERNORS WHO
HAVE PROVEN THAT LESS
GOVERNMENT, LESS SPENDING AND

LOWER TAXES IS A FORMULA THAT WORKS.

AND IT HAS BEEN REPUBLICAN **GOVERNORS WHOSE INNOVATIONS** IN EDUCATION, CRIME, AND WELFARE REFORM HAVE DRIVEN THE NATIONAL AGENDA. AND NOW, AMERICA HAS 30 STATES WHERE REPUBLICAN PRINCIPLES AND REPUBLICAN INNOVATIONS WILL BE PUT TO WORK.

SECOND, THE OVERWHELMING RE-ELECTION OF MANY REPUBLICAN **GOVERNORS ALSO PROVIDED OUR** PARTY WITH AN ENTIRE NEW "FARM TEAM" OF NEW TALENT--AS THE COATTAILS OF GOVERNORS LIKE GEORGE VOINOVICH, JIM **EDGAR, AND PETE WILSON CARRIED** CANDIDATES FOR STATE OFFICE AND STATE LEGISLATURES TO VICTORY.

AND IT SEEMS TO ME THAT I'VE READ SOMETHING RECENTLY **ABOUT THERE BEING AN ELECTION** IN 1996. AND 30 REPUBLICAN **GOVERNORS ALSO MEANS THAT OUR CANDIDATE WILL HAVE GRASS ROOTS ORGANIZATIONS READY TO** GO IN 30 STATES--INCLUDING CALIFORNIA, NEW YORK, TEXAS, OHIO, MICHIGAN, NEW JERSEY AND ILLINOIS.

IN FACT, GIVEN THE SUCCESS OF OUR REPUBLICAN GOVERNORS, IT'S NO WONDER THAT ONE OR TWO OF THEM HAVE THOUGHT ABOUT 1996, THEMSELVES. WHEN I WALKED INTO THE RECEPTION EARLIER THIS EVENING, I SHOUTED "HELLO, MR. PRESIDENT," AND **EVERYONE IN THE ROOM TURNED AROUND--INCLUDING CHRISTIE**

WHITMAN WHO SAID, "I PREFER MADAM PRESIDENT."

THESE ARE GOOD TIMES FOR THE REPUBLICAN PARTY. IT'S BEEN A LONG, LONG EFFORT TO ACHIEVE **MAJORITY STATUS ON CAPITOL** HILL AND MAJORITY STATUS ACROSS AMERICA. AND WE HAVE **EARNED THE RIGHT TO CELEBRATE** AT EVENTS LIKE THIS AND AT ANOTHER DINNER WE'LL HAVING

NEXT WEEK. AND I THANK ALL THOSE HERE TONIGHT WHO **ACTUALLY PAID FOR A TICKET. BUT REPUBLICANS KNOW THAT** IF WE WANT TO HAVE ANYTHING TO CELEBRATE IN THE YEARS AHEAD, WE NEED TO KEEP OUR PROMISES TO THE AMERICAN PEOPLE.

THERE WAS A SURVEY
RECENTLY WHERE AMERICANS

WERE ASKED WHAT MADE THEM
"VERY ANGRY." AND OVER HALF
OF THOSE RESPONDING SAID
"PEOPLE IN POSITIONS OF POWER
WHO SAY ONE THING AND DO
ANOTHER."

IF 1994 IS TO BE THE BEGINNING
OF A NEW REPUBLICAN MAJORITY-RATHER THAN JUST OUR HIGH
WATER MARK--THEN WE MUST
PROVE TO A SKEPTICAL AMERICAN

PUBLIC THAT OUR ACTIONS WILL MATCH OUR WORDS.

ON THE FEDERAL LEVEL, THAT MEANS KEEPING OUR PROMISE TO MAKE CONGRESS PART OF THE SOLUTION, AND NOT PART OF THE PROBLEM. AND WE STARTED TO DO THAT WHEN WE PASSED CONGRESSIONAL COMPLIANCE LEGISLATION.

TO FORCE THE FEDERAL

GOVERNMENT TO DO WHAT ALL

STATE GOVERNMENTS AND ALL

AMERICAN FAMILIES HAVE TO DO--
BALANCE THE BUDGET.

THE HOUSE ACTED LAST WEEK,
AND THE SENATE BEGAN THE
PROCESS TODAY. IT WILL BE A
TOUGH FIGHT. SENATOR BYRD
KNOWS THE SENATE RULES BETTER

THAN ANYONE ELSE. IN FACT, HE WROTE MOST OF THEM. BUT IN THE END, I THINK WE WILL WIN A VICTORY FOR THE PEOPLE BY SENDING A BALANCED BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE STATES.

AND WE CAN KEEP OUR WORD
TO THE PEOPLE BY LIVING UP TO
OUR PROMISE TO DUST OFF THE
10TH AMENDMENT AND RESTORE IT
TO ITS RIGHTFUL PLACE IN THE

WISCONSIN. AND HE DELIVERED.

NEW HAMPSHIRE TO UTAH, AND
FROM MINNESOTA TO MONTANA.
