**GOVERNMENT DISCRIMINATE IN**  
**FAVOR OF ONE PERSON OVER**

**ANOTHER, SIMPLY BECAUSE OF HIS  
GENDER OR HIS RACE OR THE  
COUNTRY OF HIS FOREFATHERS?**

**I THINK THE ANSWER IS NO.**

**I WANT A COLOR-BLIND  
AMERICA, ONE THAT LIVES UP TO  
THE DREAMS OF MARTIN LUTHER  
KING, WHERE EACH OF US IS  
JUDGED BY THE CONTENT OF OUR  
CHARACTER AND NOT BY THE  
COLOR OF OUR SKIN.**

**I'VE ASKED FOR, AND JUST RECEIVED, A REPORT ON EVERY FEDERAL LAW, REGULATION AND POLICY THAT GRANTS PREFERENCE TO PEOPLE SIMPLY ON THE BASIS OF THEIR RACE, ETHNIC BACKGROUND, OR GENDER.**

**THE REPORT DOCUMENTS HOW FAR WE HAVE WANDERED FROM THE ORIGINAL INTENTIONS OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS LEGISLATION OF THE**

**1960'S, AND I WILL USE IT TO FIND  
AND REPEAL LAWS AND  
REGULATIONS THAT FOR TOO LONG  
HAVE BEEN PITTING ONE AMERICAN  
AGAINST ANOTHER.**

**I WILL NOT REST UNTIL WE  
RESTORE THE DEFINITION OF EQUAL  
OPPORTUNITY INTENDED BY OUR  
FOUNDING FATHERS--ONE WHERE  
RIGHTS WERE GRANTED TO**



**INDIVIDUALS, NOT TO GROUPS OR  
FACTIONS.**

**AND WHILE I'VE SPENT A LOT OF  
TIME TALKING ABOUT LIMITING  
GOVERNMENT--THERE IS ONE  
RESPONSIBILITY THAT ONLY THE  
FEDERAL GOVERNMENT HAS--AND  
THAT IS TO PROTECT OUR  
FREEDOM.**

**WE MUST NEVER BE RELUCTANT  
ABOUT OUR GREATNESS OR**

**ASHAMED OF OUR STRENGTH.**

**AMERICA HAS BEEN THE GREATEST  
FORCE FOR GOOD THE WORLD HAS  
EVER KNOWN.**

**WE MUST STOP PLACING THE  
AGENDA OF THE UNITED NATIONS  
BEFORE THE INTERESTS OF THE

**AS WE WALKED AND TALKED

YOUTH...THE AMERICA WE RISKED  
OUR LIVES TO PROTECT, AND  
ABOUT OUR HOPES FOR THE  
GENERATIONS WHO WOULD
