**THE REPORT DOCUMENTS HOW

THE ORIGINAL INTENTIONS OF THE  
CIVIL RIGHTS LEGISLATION OF THE  
1960'S, AND I WILL USE IT TO FIND  
AND REPEAL LAWS AND  
REGULATIONS THAT FOR TOO LONG**



**HAVE BEEN PITTING ONE AMERICAN

**I WILL NOT REST UNTIL WE
