NEXT JANUARY.

LET ME ALSO SAY TO PAT
ROBERTS, WHO IS MY CONGRESSMAN.
AS OF TOMORROW, PAT, I WILL BE
JUST LIKE ANY OF YOUR OTHER

CONSTITUENTS, AND MY QUESTION
TO YOU IS "WHAT HAVE YOU DONE
FOR ME LATELY?"

AS YOU MIGHT EXPECT, DURING
THESE FINAL DAYS ON CAPITOL HILL,
I'VE BEEN ENGAGED IN A LITTLE
REMINISCING...AND I CAN'T HELP BUT
THINK BACK TO THE FOUR TERMS
THAT I SERVED IN THIS BODY.

BACK THEN, FRESHMAN WERE TO

BE SEEN AND NOT HEARD--WHICH

NEWT HAS TOLD ME A TIME OR TWO

JERRY FORD WAS BACK IN THE
CAPITOL LAST WEEK, AND I RECALLED

DEFICITS THAT THREATEN OUR
FUTURE.

WE FOUGHT TO GIVE THE
AMERICAN PEOPLE FREEDOM FROM
EXCESSIVE TAXATION.

WE FOUGHT TO GIVE THE
AMERICAN PEOPLE FREEDOM FROM

INTRUSIVE EXCESSIVE FEDERAL REGULATION.

WE FOUGHT TO FREE THOSE

AMERICANS WHO ARE TRAPPED IN A

FAILED WELFARE SYSTEM.

WE FOUGHT TO FREE AMERICA'S
SENIORS FROM THE WORRY THAT

WILLING, COME NEXT JANUARY, WHEN
YOU CALL THE WHITE HOUSE, YOU'RE
GOING TO FIND A PRESIDENT WHO
WILL FIGHT WITH YOU TO GIVE THE
AMERICAN PEOPLE THE CHANGE THEY
WANT AND DESERVE, RATHER THAN

WHO WILL FIGHT FOR THE STATUS
QUO.

AS SOME OF YOU KNOW, I AM A GREAT ADMIRER OF DWIGHT EISENHOWER.

AND IN CLOSING, I WANT TO SHARE WITH YOU A STORY TOLD ABOUT THE NIGHT IN 1945, WHEN GENERAL DWIGHT EISENHOWER WAS WALKING ALONG THE RHINE, THINKING OF THE CROSSING IN WHICH HE WOULD LEAD THE ALLIED ARMIES.

ON HIS WALK, HE MET A SOLDIER,
AND ASKED HIM WHY HE WASN'T
SLEEPING. THE YOUNG G.I., WHO
DIDN'T RECOGNIZE EISENHOWER IN
THE DARK, SAID, "I GUESS I'M JUST A
LITTLE NERVOUS."

"SO AM I," SAID EISENHOWER.

"LET'S WALK TOGETHER, AND

PERHAPS WE'LL DRAW STRENGTH

FROM ONE ANOTHER."

I AM CONFIDENT THAT AS LONG WE WALK TOGETHER AND DRAW

STRENGTH FROM ONE ANOTHER THEN
WE WILL BE VICTORIOUS IN
NOVEMBER, AND WE WILL ENSURE
THAT AMERICA'S BEST DAYS ARE YET
TO COME.
