

Dear Bob:

Thank you very much for the hard work in getting 34 of your colleagues to vote against S. 1722, the Emergency Unemployment Compensation Act. I realize that it was a difficult vote for many Senators, particularly those from states with high unemployment. I truly believe, however, that by sustaining my anticipated veto on this legislation, we will eventually sign into law the Dole-Domenici Deficit-Neutral Unemployment Compensation Act of 1991. This will ensure that unemployed workers will receive additional benefits without having to abandon the budget agreement.

Again, I commend you for your outstanding leadership on this important issue. Thanks for your help in holding the line.
