Thank you for your letter bringing to my attention the impact of the E.U. Common Agricultural Policy reform on U.S. exports and urging the approval of wheat flour sales under the Export Enhancement Program.

We are committed to ensuring the competitiveness of the U.S. agricultural exports despite budget constraints on the Export Enhancement Program. USDA is in close contact with the Millers National Federation on this issue and will continue to support its efforts to expand its exports.

I am asking Acting Secretary Rominger to review this matter and share his findings with you. Once again, thank you for your comments. I look forward to your continued input and advice on this matter.
