Dear Bob:


Please forgive me for not answering yours of June 27th, transmitting the witness list for the SALT II hearing, but I simply went to work on it with the staff and the letter got caught up in the effort.

Two of those you list, Professor Brennan and Dr. Ikle, are appearing at our hearings. The current phase of these hearings will terminate July 31 with the testimony of Dr. Kissinger. We will then review in the Committee what follow-on hearings should be included in the first two weeks of September. I will, then, again cause the remaining names to be reviewed.

As to the testimony of Senators, that, too, will be addressed by the Committee before we leave on Recess, and I have little doubt that some suitable decision will be made. Please have Mike Packard keep in touch with the Minority's Chief of Staff, Peter Lakeland.
