Dear Senator Dole:

It is with a deep sense of privilege that I transmit to you the Report of the President's Commission on the Holocaust. In its report the Commission recommends the creation of a living memorial which will include a memorial museum to tell the story of the Holocaust, an educational foundation to stimulate scholarship, teaching, and research, and a citizen's committee on conscience to undertake action to prevent a recurrence. It is our hope that the memorial will be built primarily through private funds.

I hope to have the opportunity to report to you in greater detail our aspirations for this project in appropriate Congressional forums.
