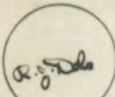

21 March 45

Not much going on today so I'll try to finish this V-mail before anything happens. I received 8 more letters today, 5 from you, one from Mrs. Bob Ruff, one from Bob's mother and I can't think right now who the other one was from. I hope you've been getting what few letters I have written. I guess I'll send everyone letters till I have a chance to get some writing done. When I'm not in my foxhole checking Sherman artillery I'm generally on night patrol or trying to catch some sleep. I'm pretty dirty right now, I haven't shaved or washed for several days but I guess it won't hurt me any. I can't see why the Japs don't give up but I'm just a second lieutenant who doesn't know too much about the big picture.

Tell everyone 'hello' for me and I'll write as soon as possible. You needn't write every other day unless you want too, just send me plenty of postages. Mom - I'm not sure about fraternity dues, if they want money take it out of my allowance. Tell Kenny hello for me, I hope Norma Jean doesn't win all of Dad's money, I may need a little when I get back. Thanks alot for all the letters. I'll write whenever possible. Goodnight
