CAMP BARKELEY, TEXAS

Dear Dad:

Well basis is almost
over with business completed.
We got back to camp today at 11:30.
As soon as I could get my clothes
off I ran for the showers and
it really is nice to be clean
after going 16 days without a
bath. We have 3 more easy days
and then we start shipping out.
I'm going to try to go back to
school if I can; there's a chance
that I could go back to N.V. and
there's nothing I'd like better
than that.

I'm sending you a box

of rations, ~~put~~ them up and see if you can make a meal out of the contents. We lived 3 days on "K" rations and they aren't very good. If you like them you'll be the first person that I know who does.

Henry will be out for one more week, if I'm still here I ~~when~~ he gets back I'll get to see him. I still haven't heard anything about a furlough but will know pretty soon one way or the other.

Had a letter from Norma Jean today and the baby seems to be doing fine and everyone is O.K. I guess.

I'm going to try and catch up on my letter writing today for I didn't write many on bivouacs.

Don't eat too much when you get the K ration, it's about like the meals we



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used to get at Propp's cafe.

Write if you have time.

Might be home in a week
or two but don't count on
it too much. We're having spring
~~with~~ weather down here, some
of the boys are walking around
with their shirts off.
