

April 9, 1945

Dear Bob-

We spent yesterday with ah Mildred

Hokie so I don't think anyone wrote to you
yesterday. Saturday night I got off at seven
o'clock and Mildred Nye came in and ate with
us. Shea Mildred + I went to Bunker and
we were going to spend the night with Hokie. We
saw their ~~car~~ car parked in front of the
Hall so in we went. Uncle John Banister was
there and of course, dancing with all of the
young girls. He grabbed me before I got
into the door and we had danced a couple
of steps and someone said, "Lick." Then
with a flash someone grabbed me
and when I looked down I saw a short
little guy that almost came to my

mail. I danced with three dances with Frank then here came Uncle John again. They were going to dance the Square Dance. He practically drug me out on the floor. It was a lot of fun though. Last night I went out and stayed with Milled Nye. Bud is working in Eldorado now. They are going to move this week sometime. They have a house in Eldorado. I rode to town with Carl Graham this morning in the truck. I started working full time this morning so I had to be there all night. Sure has been plenty windy all day. Mom was washing by the time I got

home. Jim got his notice today. He has to take his physical exam this Saturday. They came out to Hoker yesterday with the folks for dinner. They had me talked into letting

Jim train me to be an operator and working
at the western union. Since I have feeling a
little tough everyone thinks I'd be better
off in an office and I'd like a place like
that because you can still reach the public.
Then today Jim got that safe so I don't
know what to do. One girl resigned last
week and one today. Gee they'll need
a whole new crew. One girl wanted to
be transferred to Mo. but they didn't
need her there & they did here. The other
girl was getting married. I think I'd like
a job like that but I'll have to wait
until Jim find out what he's going to
do. I can go to Springfield, Mo. and train
for six weeks.

The folks just went for a spin
around the block. I think they took
Hella & Jake along.

How are you Bob? Gee, I hope

you're feeling good and taking care of yourself.
Did mom tell you that Mary Ann
had a new 9 1/2 lb. baby girl? Ray'll know
what she finally named it. Guess
Johnny is plenty tickled about her.
Well, Bob don't know of much
news so I'll sign off for this
time. Be a good boy and write real
soon.
