Dear Bob,

I called home Friday night. Mom said they had gotten a letter from you written in your own hand writing. She has been pretty worried about you. I'm so glad you got to Dr Eugene Cuff. Hope he can visit you there at the hospital. Oh I hope you're feeling better. How you think your arm?

Shoulder will be okay? It might take it quite a bit of time. Just hope you don't get too impatient. Keep your chin up and don't let it get you down.

The weather here was nice today. Sumed good not to go to school although I like it very much. We will start on our 4th week tomorrow.

Being I thought the folks were coming down this weekend I didn't send your gift so I've decided to wait until next week. Hope you think what I got her was okay. I'm sure still be thrilled with it. It's a sterling silver compact. Shows a small heart in the upper left hand corner.

The compact itself is heart
shaped. Anyhow I had
it engraved like this.

Guess Kenny is still
where he was. Will be
moving soon I guess. Wish
with he could stay where
he is.

was taking it pretty bad
when I told her.

make a B 29 air base out
of the Yuma Army Air Field.
