Little Steve is sure a sweet little thing. I had an awful time trying to keep him dry. Then tonight we ate a chicken dinner at Bob & Nell's. Dad came home early because ^{he} thought you might call. I had to go back to work. Nell may go to K.C. over the weekend and if so shall stop there. I may not come down Sunday. Thought I'd better stay home & get the house cleaned. I have some ironing to do, cupboards to clean & a little bit of everything to do. Going to ~~the~~ try to get the basement cleaned before Sister gets home. My hair has been changed again so I don't have a lot of time during the day.

Betty Byler Warford has a birthday

tomorrow so her little sis is having a party on her. May go up for awhile after I get off work. I just wrote Kenny a twelve page letter. Sounds about like Sister but I told him a lot of things I know he'll be interested in. Gladys also wrote to Kenny & you today. I'm going to drop Sister a few lines too. Angelina called Dad today and asked all about how you were & what you had to say when you called. She has another week's vacation this coming week. So she may go to K.C.

The weather has really been swell today. I've been kidding Dad about lightning the stove. you should hear him rave.

Seems mighty funny without Miller's down stairs. Bessie went down home with her mother for a week so its pretty lonesome around here. Pap went to bed & is snoring as usual.
