Just a few lines today to say hello and to let you know that I am getting along OK and feeling just fine hoping this finds all of you the same, as far as news there is very little but I hear there is to be a change in the point system soon and I do hope that it is not a rumor, because every time they lower the point system it puts me just a little closer to where I would give anything to be and that is home, the days are getting just a little longer and the weeks a little farther apart now that the war is finally over, but I can wait as I am one boy who can afford to wait as I do have so very much to come home to they finally sent a

that have been over here
so long however they only took
a few, but it means that they
are at least starting and that
is just what we have all
been waiting for, all I hope
now is that I don't have
to go to Japan as ~~an~~ occupation
for it will mean nothing more
than guard duty or an m. p.
and I wouldn't like that
at all, however I am only
guessing and hoping that
someone doesn't get the
idea that I am the
man for the job, but as
yet there hasn't been any
rumors, as for as what I
am doing here is nothing
more than killing time now
that almost everyone has
pulled out to go to Japan -
