comes to go home, as I do

trying to tell you.

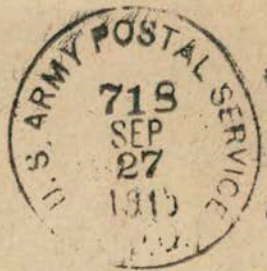
I still haven't received
