4-30-1945.

Dear Bob, This is Monday, Mom and Peggy
have gone to the show, Peggy come over
to stay all night, while her mother went
up to the Hospital to try and find her a
policy brother, We didn't get any mail over
the week end, but expect to hear from both
you and Kenney in a few days, The war
news on your side is very good & believe
it will be over in a day or two, It is
very quiet around here, M.G. being gone, Most
of went to church yesterday & spent the bal of
the day in the yard & looking for material
for the fire place, We were out South
east of town near Graham road when a
B-29 fell Sat, all the crew bailed out
and were saved but one, The plane
was from the base at Great Bend, the
whole town locked up Sat eve about 7pm
the false report come in about Germany so
we are expecting the real news, Most
any time, we still havent talked to them

At Aubyn, & they don't get from that, the
Mail is slow from there. Now, & we are all
hope he is O.K. Sgt Michie have a couple
weeks off and are going to Harrow to spend
about 10 days; we haven't heard from Larry
& Gloria it looks like they will be in
Yuma until after the War, M.J. likes his
work & guess they keep her real busy, she
will work in the W.U. Office here when she
comes back, if there is any thing you
need be sure & let us know; we still
haven't heard from your locker, but will
collect what ever isn't you think is O.K.
Mom said to tell you she would write
to-morrow so will call this good-bye,
hope you are getting along O.K. & write
when you can, will love you know
about what Gladys gets as soon as we
hear, So Long for Now.
