The application is being processed by Headquarters 75th Infantry Division, Camp Breckenridge. I quite understand this suggestion may run contrary to your policy and practice--in which case give it the usual treatment.

I had hoped to get back to Russell for a visit with my folks this fall but doubt that I'll be able to do so. You should come out here sometime and have a look around. Don't believe all you hear about California sunshine. I still like the Kansas brand (minus the hot southwest wind).
