I don't know whether they will send me back to the state or keep me here until my foot gets

went and then send me
back to the outfit. They
were all sending a lot of
the boys back to the
states.

Do you have enough
points to get out of the
army? I'm sure you will
get out anyway if you haven't
got enough points. I only
have 32 points.

I received a letter from
Koenig today thanking
me for writing them a
letter for you. I'm just
thankful that I was able
to write for you. I hope
you are able to write
your own letters now.

I go to the show just about every day and they usually have a ball game every evening.

Do you ever have ice cream for show? We have it once a week. There isn't much to write about so I'll close hoping you are getting along okay.
