Sure nice you have a few, right at your door!

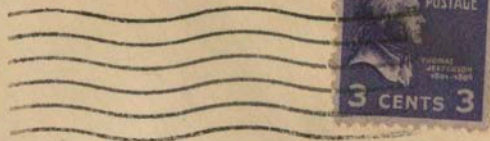
