work and take it easy -

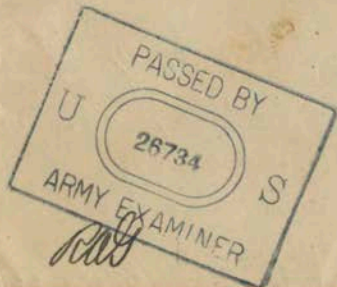
