I imagine you never expected me to write to you but I have never had enough time to write but I have a few minutes so I will try to write a few lines, regardless of what I can think of to write about. I was wondering whether or not you still plan on going to nurses training or not I hope you get the opportunity as I know you have the abilities that it takes, from what I have seen of Army nurses over here they don't have such a good deal and they have a pretty tough life because it is tough over here regardless of what your job is, I just thought I would pass it along to you as it may be of some help in making your decision about going. You said that Normie wrote to me quite some time back but as yet I have never received any mail from her, it may be that it hasn't arrived but I would really enjoy hearing from her and also some of the rest of the old gang, I know it is my place to write first but I just cannot possibly find time to get around to it, it is about all I can do to write to the folk's and you know that they come first. I received a letter from you yesterday that was written some time in January of February you see I don't go by days over here it is all month's and it looks like a long stretch at the present time However the war can be won overnight but it doesn't ever seem to be the right night as yet for miracles, well sis I can't think of anything else to write about at the present so I had better start this thing to a flying close before I make so many errors that you can't read it. Please send me those snapshots that you tell me so much about I would really enjoy them, so long for now and keep the mail coming

I have received more mail from you than an one else and I don't know to say it but you have pulled me through more than once. Thank's Sis
