our next march is seven miles in
one hour so you can see we
really are getting a basic training
and then a four mile in 45 minutes
we have 3 a week, I have K.P.
again Sunday, and I am room
orderly tomorrow. I have to make
beds, scrub the floor sweep it
and straighten all the shelves
and then I go out and march
so they keep me plenty busy
but I really @. like to work
as it takes my mind off
everything else, and the time goes
plenty fast it must be
long now and I can come
home I hope. tell dad to
get another "car" before I get
home. a Buick will do. or
a Chrysler, well so long for now.
