my furlough if I should  
happen to get one, the  
best way to send money  
to Bob & I is by a  
postal check and you can  
cash them here in camp but  
any other way you have to go to  
town and ~~get~~ to get  
your money, I hope I can  
get that money dead straight  
out so I can send you and  
have it put in the Bank.  
Tell Bud Hanson to write me  
give him my address, also  
send me Dean K. address

used to know. Do I have to  
write Mr. Hagan to get the  
paper or can you get  
them for me, I will try to  
see Pat Sunday but I  
think I have R.P. all day
