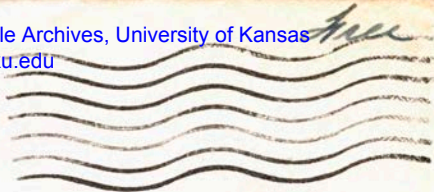
Well I must close for now &
