today, I worked in a  
collecting station and  
I was in charge of loading  
the Ambulances tomorrow  
we run the clearing station  
and all we will do is  
sit around all day until  
over

do patients come through  
and then we look over  
the bandages and see  
if they are ok and then  
we take them off, so  
there isn't too much to do  
tomorrow, about the only  
thing that we have to do  
yet that will be tough is  
marching back to camp  
and I will be so glad to  
get back it won't bother  
me a bit, I have some  
pictures and a fellow is  
going to bring them out so  
I will send them to you

as soon as he brings  
them out, Emil got a  
money order yesterday  
so if we get a furlough  
we are all set

Why don't you go  
pleasant hunting, there is  
a swell place out by the  
place. A man Schneider  
used to live it is on the  
Emil Hansen place but  
when we got some last year  
as you can go out to Herman  
Langholter, or Jake Fink's  
over

I had better  
close for now and  
drop a line to mom, so  
I will write again tomorrow  
as I will have a lot of  
time,
