been busy the last week.

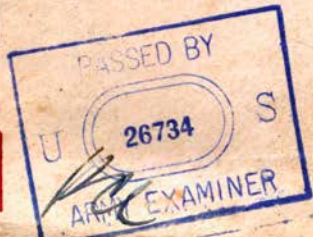
they shipped a big bunch out
