Just of all we left for overseas from San Francisco, but I cannot tell you the date, also I cannot tell you the name of the ship as yet I can't say very much about the trip and except I didn't like as much as I thought I would, although I never did get sea-sick, I felt as though I was going to at times, I was also initiated when we crossed the Equator they cut my hair off and put

is at home and it is ice cold  
I still don't shame, I guess  
I am not a man yet but

I don't have too. We have tents  
to sleep in and a coudder for  
light, the food is pretty
