Dear Folk's:

Just enough time to drop you a very few short lines, I haven't heard from you for the past few days but hope to soon, the mail was held up again for some reason and should be coming through soo. No news from this part of the part of the world except that I am feeling just fine and am getting along just fine hope this short note finds you all the same, the weather here is about the same except it forgot to rain again today, very unusual for this part of the country. I was fortunate enough to hear the latest war news of Europe and it really sounds good to me I wouldn't be a bit surprised to see that war over within a very few month, let's hope it won't be too long, how is everyone getting along, and by the way have you finished working on the house as yet, I bet when I get home I won't know the place, wish I were there now to see the house I bet it really is swell, have you ever put up a bar in the basement yet, I suppose dad will be working on that before long, it would be a nice thing to have especially after the war is over and some of my buddies come in to see me it would be just the thing, but it is only a minor suggestion, I hope Bob comes through ok in ocs. I can't think of any more to write about and it is about time for me to go and eat breakfast so I will drpp you a few lines again soon, I see that I still have enough room to tell you that I expect to be located here for some time of course you know the army by now as well as I do and they canchange everything overnight, so if you want to send my watch on I think my address at present will carry it directly to me without any trouble, at lea t let's hope so, well I must go and eat, so will say so long for now hoping to hear from all of you in the war future.
