I have been going to write to you the last few days but have been so busy that I haven't had hardly enough time to sleep, so please forgive me for not writing to you any sooner, as I remember I promised to write to you every day and as I have said I have been so busy, about fourteen hours per day and no overtime of time and one half just seven days a week but I don't mind as I know that I am doing a good job, and it is adding to the final day when our yellow friends stick their neck out too far and get in the way of one of our bullets, I received your last letter and it took only nine days for it to reach me, I was really surprised to say the least, also I received some more pictures, it looks like I am going to have to get me a sack to carry them in but I enjoy all of them very much, in fact they are my most prized possession and when I feel just a little low I take them out and look at all of them you can't imagine how much they help my moral, I bet I have the best folk's any fellow ever had and I don't know what I will do when I get back home again I have given it some thought but of course plans can be changed very easily over here, but Frank and I plan to take us a vacation, and from there I don't know just what we will do, I may go to college, and I am thinking about it a great deal lately, as I can see where an education after this war will be the only means of survival, at least it looks that way to me at the present time, well I haven't told you very much and I don't have much to write about so I will bring this to a close, hoping to hear from you soon, I think this address will last for sometime but don't bank
