I don't like this place at all but I would rather stay here than go to Jofar, as it would only mean packing up and moving again and the only boat ride I want to take now is the one to the good old U.S.A., they say by the first of the year that all men with 2 yrs. service will be sent home and discharged of course I hope they are right as it will make me eligible to go home, and that is just where I want to be and as soon as possible!
